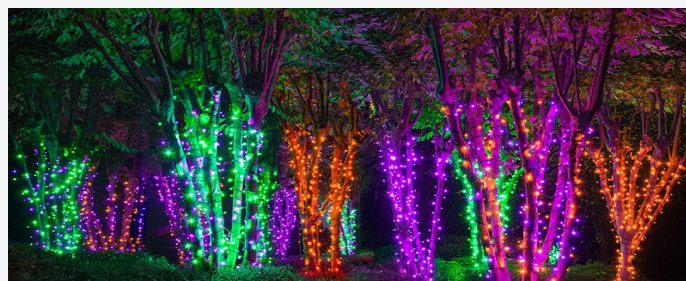


Hunt launches HEART Program

Seasonal Updates

Decorative lighting for holidays is authorized but cannot be put up earlier than one month prior to the occasion and must be removed no later than one week after the occasion. All outside lights are to be turned off no later than midnight. Running electric cords through windows and doors or across heating and air systems is prohibited. The use of staples, nails, screws or other mechanical fasteners to attach decorations to homes is prohibited
